^ CONFESSION OF FAITH

Minister: Christian, what do you

believe?

Congregation (Nicene Creed): I believe in One God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. "MAY I COME TO THE LORD'S TABLE?"

The Lord's Supper is observed every Lord's Day at King's Covenant Church. We warmly invite to the Lord's table all those who are baptized disciples of Jesus Christ, under the authority of Christ and His body, the Church. Since the elders are responsible for the table, when a baptized child begins taking the Lord's Supper, we ask a parent to notify one of the elders. By eating the bread and drinking the wine with us as a visitor, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation. You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament. If you have any doubt about your participation, please speak to the elders before or after the service.
